The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 10 will hold a special meeting on Thursday, June 20, 2019, at 8:30 a.m., at the RiverPark Subdivision Recreation Center, 5875 Summit Creek Dr., Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Engineering matters, including pay estimates and change orders for the following projects:
  - a. repair of District facilities, including:
    - i. retention pond slopes of lake no. 4;
    - ii. discuss District's outfall structure;
    - iii. channel erosion repair; and
  - b. deeds and easements.
2. Capital Improvement Plan.
3. Discuss Richmond Gage action plan, make necessary updates and authorize corresponding notices.
4. Park and recreational facilities, including:
  - a. update from Park Rangers LLC regarding playground inspections and park projects; and
  - b. purchase facilities or authorize repair of District park facilities.
5. Operation of District facilities, including repair of wooden fences.
6. Tour District facilities and authorize installation of bollards and cables or alternate deterrent for unauthorized access to District's levee.
7. Perimeter levee matters, including Fort Bend Flood Management Association membership.
8. Discuss irrigation matters.
