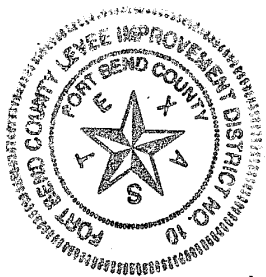



NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 10 will hold a special meeting on Friday, March 8, 2024, at **8:30 a.m.**, at the RiverPark Subdivision Recreation Center, 5875 Summit Creek Dr., Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, approval of pay estimates, change orders, and/or final acceptance, construction related consultant proposals, and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facilities, if appropriate, for the following:
 - a. park design projects, including:
 - i. Park at the Levee (Enclave); and
 - ii. Overlook Trail Extension.
3. Park and recreational facilities matters, including:
 - a. update from Park Rangers LLC regarding playground inspections and park projects;
 - b. purchase facilities or authorize repair of District park facilities; and
 - c. design of new park facilities.
4. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs, maintenance, approve proposals; and
 - b. Brazos River erosion status and repairs.
5. Landscaping matters, including update from Houston Landscapes Unlimited.
6. Update from C.I.A. Services.
7. Discuss next meeting agenda items, location, date, and time.
